

IBM Z ISV Technical Disclosure Meeting (TDM)

The IBM Z ISV Technical Disclosure Meetings are part of the IBM Z ISV Early Programs. TDMs are two to five day education events normally held twice per year in Poughkeepsie, NY where IBM discloses detailed pre-GA product technical information about upcoming IBM software and hardware to Independent Software Vendors (ISVs). The technical material presented provides ISVs with the information needed to exploit new features or modify their applications to support the IBM System z environment in the future

In order to participate in these programs an ISV must:

1. Be a member of the IBM PartnerWorld Program, developing and selling, or interested in developing and selling products that run on the System z platform.
2. Have a signed IBM Z ISV Early Programs Confidential Disclosure Agreement (CDA) in place with IBM.

Other conditions may apply that may limit an ISV's participation in the System z ISV Early Programs and the TDMs.

The TDMs are fee-based events. The ISVs are responsible for their own expenses and a registration fee of \$400 for the full event (fee may be subject to change). The TDM includes IBM Executive presentations as well as other topics of interest to the ISV developers.

The next IBM Z ISV Technical Disclosure Meeting will be held October 23, 2018 through October 25, 2018 in Poughkeepsie NY. The actual length of this event is dependant on final content.
